

SGEG – Volunteers needed for planting 6000 bulbs now, to brighten up the village next Spring!



Shamley Green Environment Group has bought over 6000 bulbs to give lovely displays of spring flowers around the trees on the Cricket Green and by the playground at Lords Hill: we've got *Narcissus pseudonarcissus* (the 'wild' daffodil) and Poet's daffodil (Pheasants Eye or *Narcissus poeticus*) and the cheerful early flowering *Crocus tommasinianus* which does so well elsewhere in the village. We're planning to have a sociable morning on **Saturday 21st October** planting them, so please do come and help. We will be starting at 10am and it will probably take a couple of hours or so, depending on how many people we get - any help would be very welcome, either helping with the planting itself or bringing along coffee and biscuits to keep the volunteers going!
