

10 Shamley Green Environment Objectives for 2022

The Shamley Green Environment Group (SGEG) was formed in 2020. Please see our new website: www.shamleygreenenvironment.co.uk for progress in 2021.

Here are our 10 objectives for 2022.

Amphibians protected during the migration season and amphibian friendly policies adopted around the village.

Birds - species and numbers in the village and surrounds recorded; native ducks encouraged to breed on the Duck Pond.

Ponds – Pond Working Group will continue with regular management, maintenance and repair to a programme agreed with the Parish Council.

Ditches – regular maintenance of ditches by the PC, Waverley and, where agreed by them, volunteers to ensure they are clear, safe and biodiversity friendly.

Trees – plan developed for tree planting, monitoring and care on Common Land involving Waverley, PC and the Tree Working Group.

Wildflowers and Mowing – mowing plan agreed by PC based on SGEG recommendations; further local fundraising and biodiversity friendly planting encouraged; progress of last year's wildflower planting recorded.

Education and publicity – website updated; articles in village media; Lord Lieutenant visit to see environment initiatives; partnerships with schools strengthened.

Recycling – information published about where SG waste goes; schools' campaign; crisp packets and other recycling initiatives started.

Volunteers – regular volunteering projects through the spring to autumn with the help of Waverley ranger.

Partnerships – links strengthened with Surrey Wildlife Trust; Surrey Botanical Society; Guildford Environment Forum; Surrey Amphibian and Reptile Group; Wonersh Environment Advisory Group.
